1.0 INTRODUCTION

The CRSR College of Special Education, Bhadrak, has been established and recognized by SSEPD Department, Govt. of Odisha, approved by Rehabilitation Council of India, New Delhi and Affiliated to Fakir Mohan University, Balasore. The main objective of the College is to enhance Human Resource or manpower Development and to provide Professional services to persons with Intellectual Disabilities and other disabilities. As a part of the Training Programmes, CRSR College offers two Academic years Teachers Training Course - Bachelor of Education in Special Education (Intellectual Disability).

The course prepares the students to work as Special Educators in Special Schools for students with ID, work as teacher in Inclusive Schools, in medical set up, and also to work as teacher in general Schools.

2.0 OBJECTIVES

To prepare teachers who can perform the following on completion of the course:-

- To develop confidence among the learners about their potentialities, abilities and usefulness to save the society with a sense of potentialities, abilities and usefulness to serve the society with a sense of freedom, self-respect and dignity.
- To develop professional competencies to educate Children/persons with Intellectual Disability.
- To know and understand various methods and approaches of organizing education of children with Intellectual Disability under inclusive, integrated and special education set up.
- To acquire knowledge & skills about nature and educational needs of children with disabilities as well as of few specific disabilities in particular.
- To understand the nature of children with Intellectual Disability in the learning process.
- To develop competencies to deal with the academic and personal problems of the learners with Intellectual Disability.
- To develop conceptual understanding of educational provisions and skills for working with children with various disabilities in special and inclusive settings.
- To develop competencies to organize various co-curricular and extracurricular activities.
- To know, understand and develop the ability to manage a Special School as well as general school enrolled Children with Disabilities.
- To Enhance Knowledge and skills on professional approach.

3.0 DURATION OF THE PROGRAMME

The duration of the programme is two academic years, which can be completed in maximum of 04 years from the date of admission.

4.0 SEATS

There are 30 seats available for the Course.

- Reservations are available as per Govt. /University norms for SC, ST, OBC/SEBC, PwDs and other candidates.

- 4.1 SC & ST: 16% of the seats for the SC (4 Seats) and 23% for ST (6 Seats) are reserved. In case of non-availability of candidates in one of these categories, seats will be filled up from the candidates belonging to General Category.
- 4.2 Persons with Disabilities: 5% (2 seats) of the total number of seats will be reserved for PWDS candidates. In case of non-availability, the seats will be filled up from the general category.
- 4.3 OBC/SEBC: 11% (3 seats) of the seats will be reserved for OBC/SEBC candidates. In case of non-availability of candidates, seats will be filled up from the candidates of the General Category.
- 4.4 50% (15 seats) of the seats are earmarked for general candidates.

5.0 ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

The candidate must fulfill the following eligibility conditions:

- 5.1 The candidate must have passed Bachelor Degree in any discipline with at least 50% marks in aggregate in case of General candidates and 45% of marks in aggregate in case of SC, ST, PwD and OBC / SEBC candidates excluding marks secured in extra optional.
- 5.2 **Age Limit** : There is no maximum age limit prescribed by the Rehabilitation Council of India, New Delhi in the syllabus for admission in to B.Ed. (SE:ID) course /programme as per letter no 91/2014/RCI-8672 dated- 07.07.2015.
- 5.3 **Caste Certificates**
In case of SC, ST and OBC / SEBC candidates, the Caste Certificate should be issued by the competent authority of the Government. The Caste Certificate shall be considered by virtue of birth only (Caste by marriage or adoption will not be considered).
- 5.4 **Disability Certificate**
The candidates are required to submit UDID Certificate issued in their favour in the prescribed form by the Medical Board countersigned by CDMO concerned. (Reservation under PwD category is for candidates with mild disability in one lower/upper limb only).

6.0 SELECTION PROCEDURE

The Selection will be made as per Career marking.

11.0 JOINING AND SUBMISSION OF CERTIFICATES
